

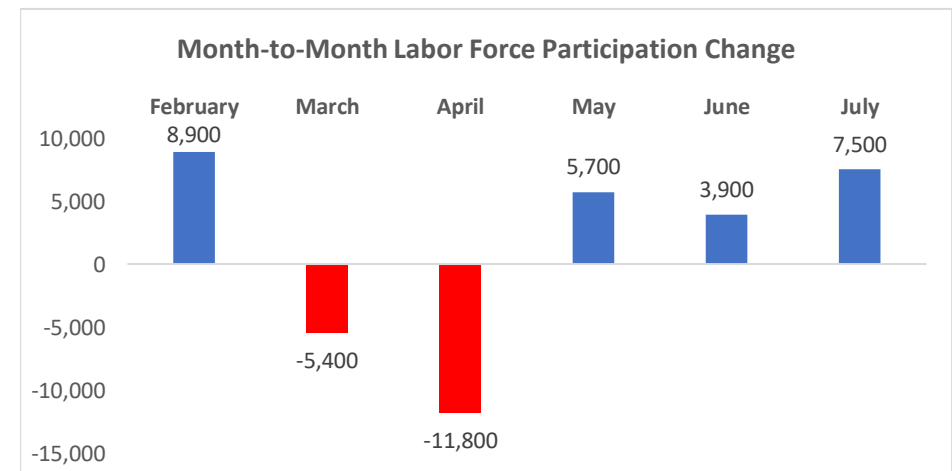
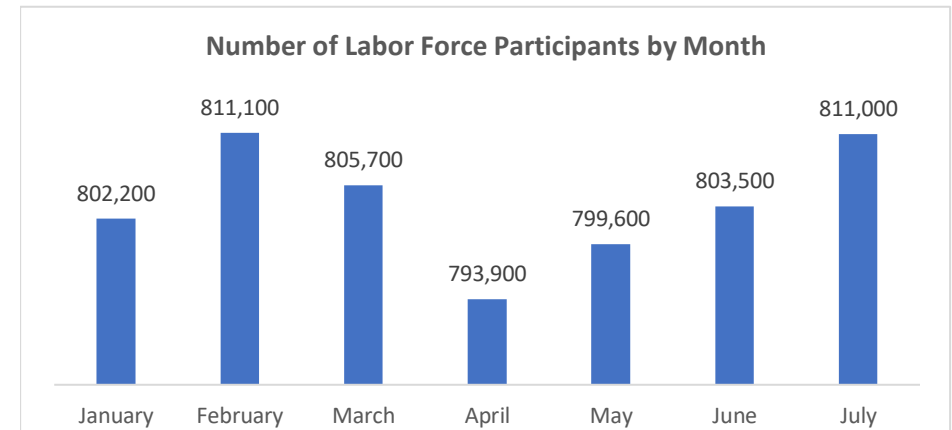


July 2021 – Labor Market Highlights in Alameda County and East Bay

Labor force (LF) participation in Alameda County in July 2021 rose by 7,500 individuals, with the most prominent growth in Oakland, Fremont, and Hayward.

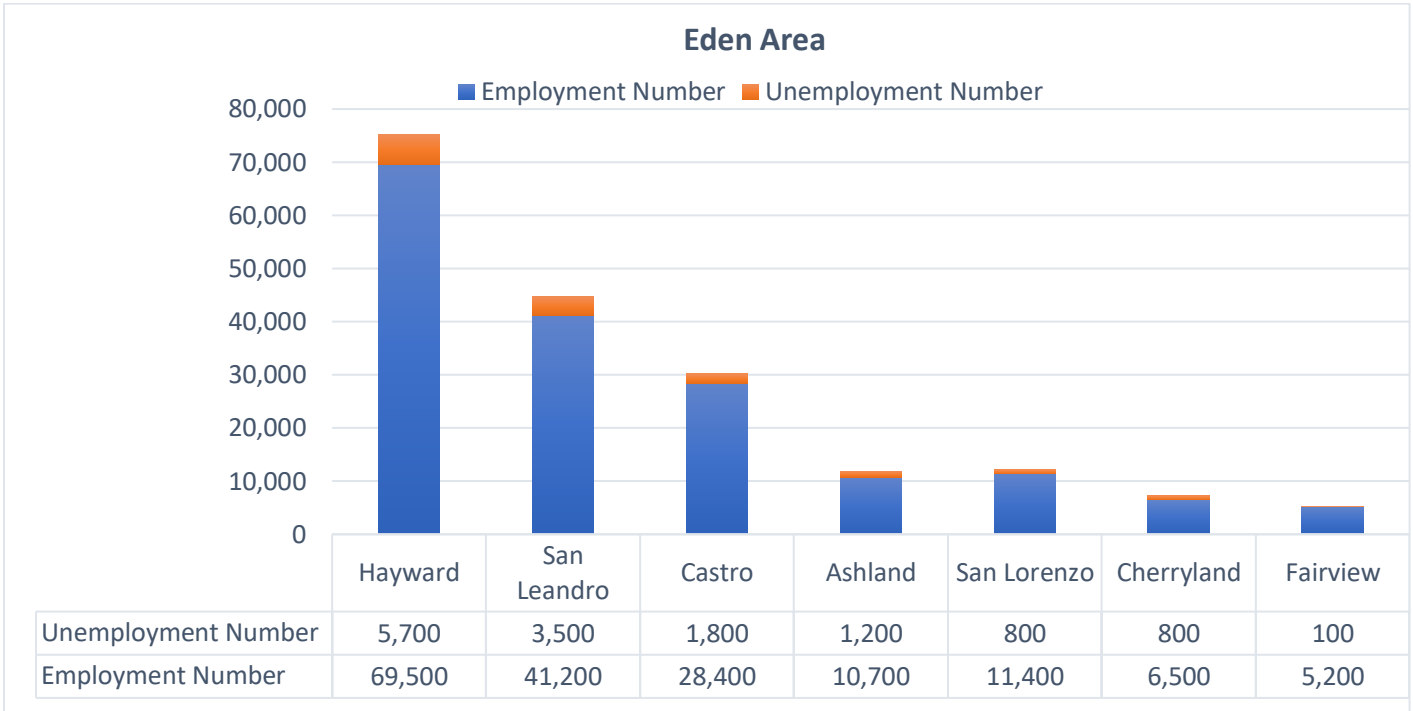
Overall, Alameda County’s unemployment rate (U.E. rate) in July 2021 improved slightly from the previous month.

The U.E. rate in Alameda County has dropped nearly one percent from the beginning of the calendar year.



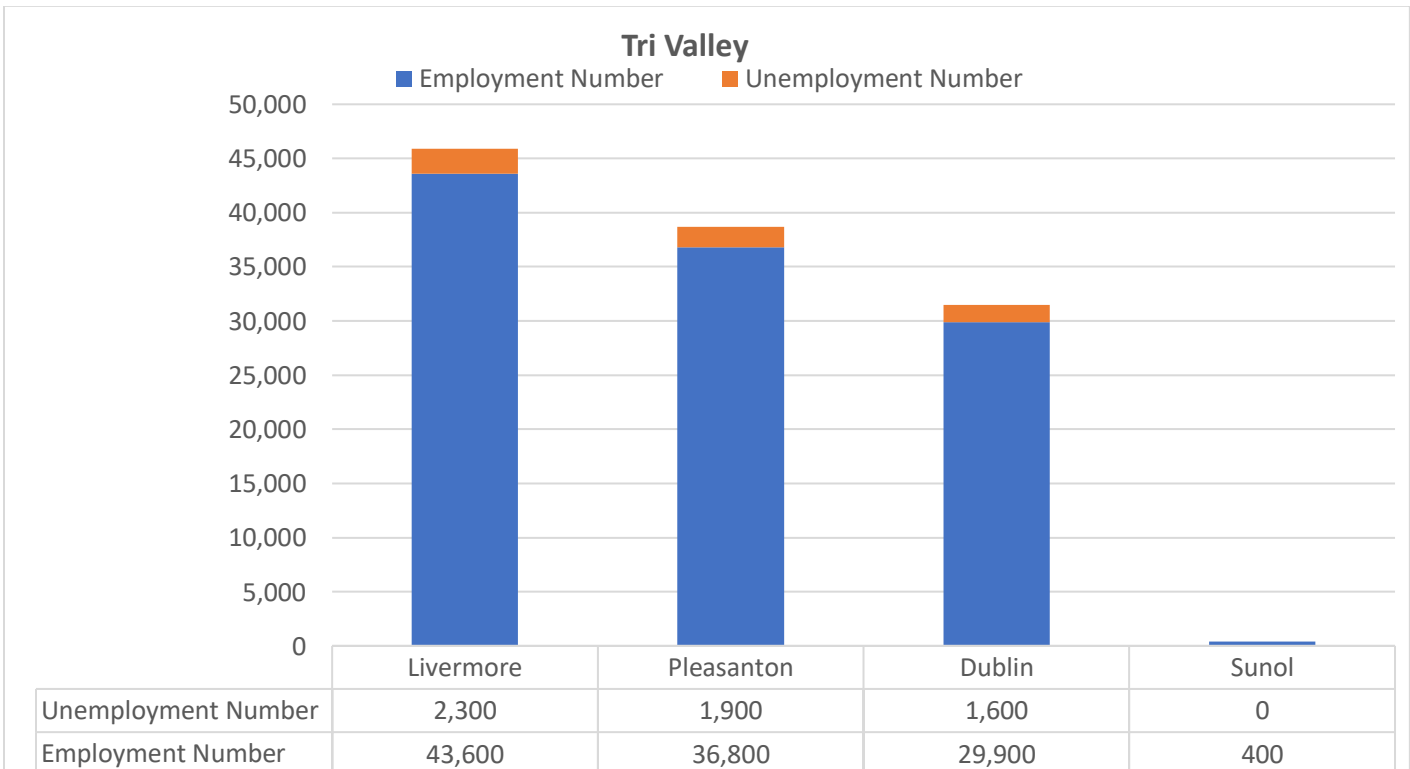
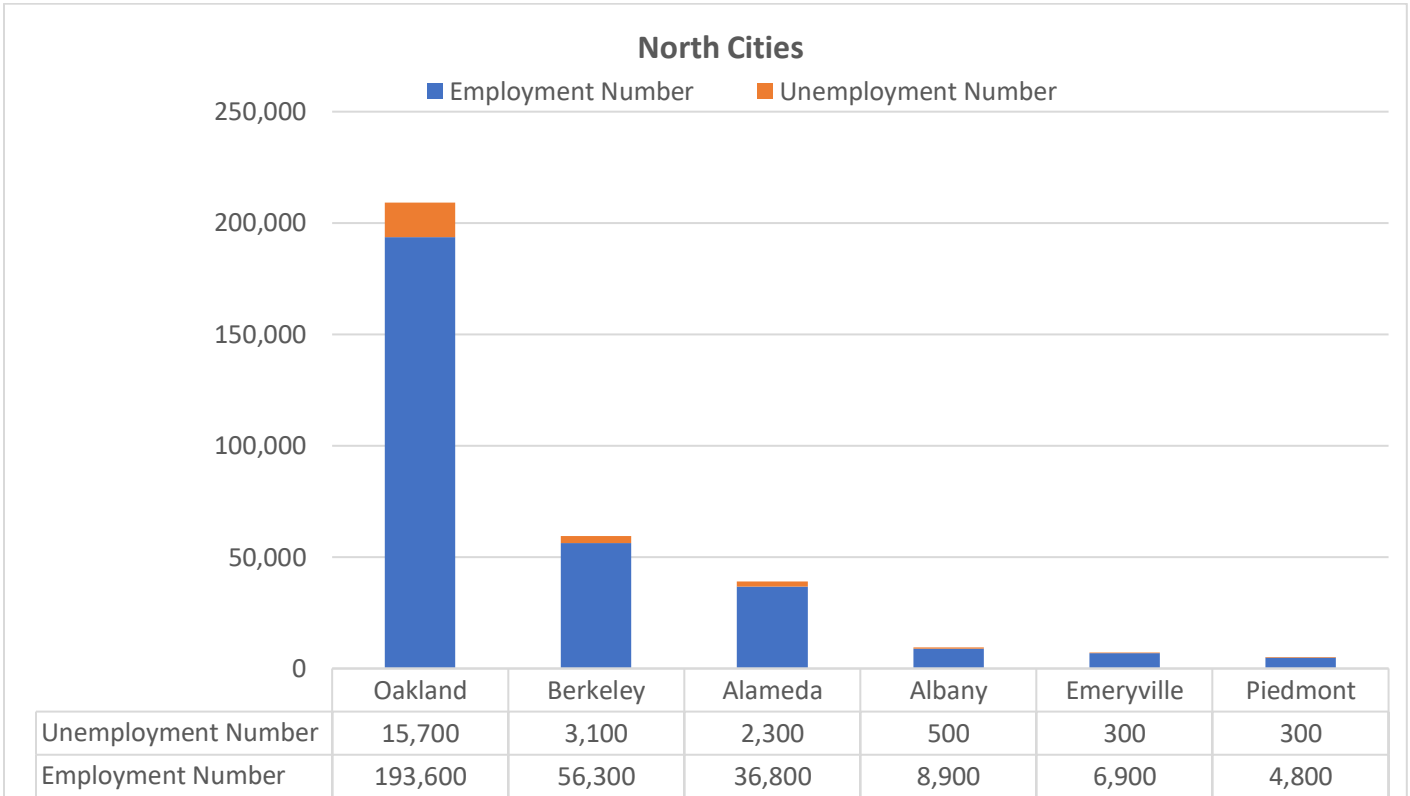
